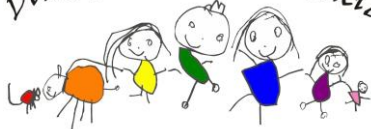

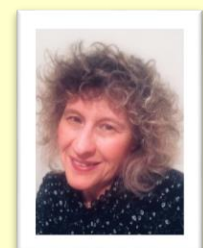
Trainers: Gill Howard and Elaine Okopski
